

# ACTION ALERT: Demand Accountability on Wireless Radiation Safety

## FDA Commissioner Confirmation Hearings – What Senators Must Ask

**The Opportunity:** The FDA removed older blanket safety assurances on cell phone radiation. The **2021 D.C. Circuit remand** on RF limits remains unresolved. Under **Public Law 90-602**, FDA holds statutory responsibility for electronic product radiation (including non-ionizing RF from cell phones). Use the upcoming confirmation to secure real commitments.

- How will FDA fulfill PL 90-602 duties instead of leaving the FCC alone?

### Key Demands

- Acknowledge FDA’s role under PL 90-602 for non-ionizing RF.
- Commit to leading a transparent assessment resolving the 2021 remand.
- Provide formal medical input to the FCC.
- Update public messaging with current evidence.
- Address modulation, vulnerable groups, and biological variability.

### Powerful Questions Senators Should Ask the Nominee

1. Do you acknowledge FDA’s responsibility under Public Law 90-602 for electronic product radiation, including RF from cell phones?
2. Will FDA lead or co-lead a comprehensive assessment to resolve the 2021 D.C. Circuit remand on RF limits?
3. How will you replace removed blanket assurances with accurate, evidence-based public messaging?
4. FDA approved modulated RF for non-thermal effects in cancer treatment. How will consumer wireless policy account for modulation and non-thermal mechanisms?
5. Will you prioritize risks to children, pregnant individuals, and those with genetic variations affecting responses?
6. Will you support an independent, conflict-free review including benchmark analyses and emerging data?
7. How will you resume federal research on long-term and real-world exposures?
8. If science requires revised limits, how should Congress address Section 704 preemption?

**Take Action Now:** Call both Senators today. Share this alert. Coordinate with Children’s Health Defense and local networks. Confirmation hearings are the leverage point — use it.
